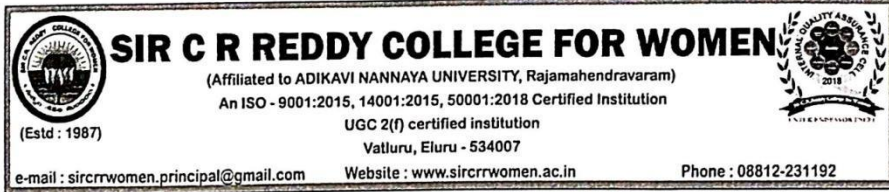

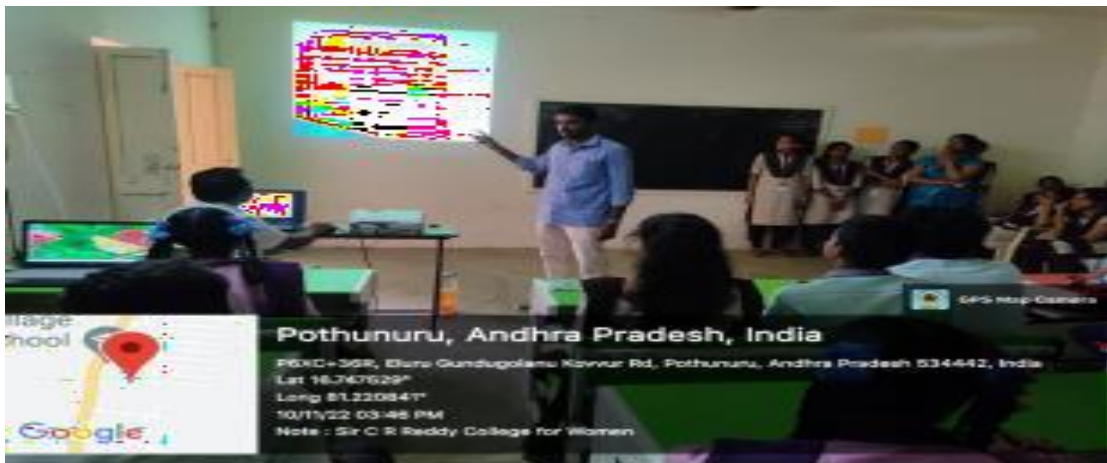
- Department of Computer Science organized a Workshop programme on “**Use of Technologies in Rural Education**” on 10-11-2022 and 11-11-2022.

- Proper training and implementation of ICT programmes in simple way and language which is easily understandable by the rural people can surely bring about revolution in rural development.



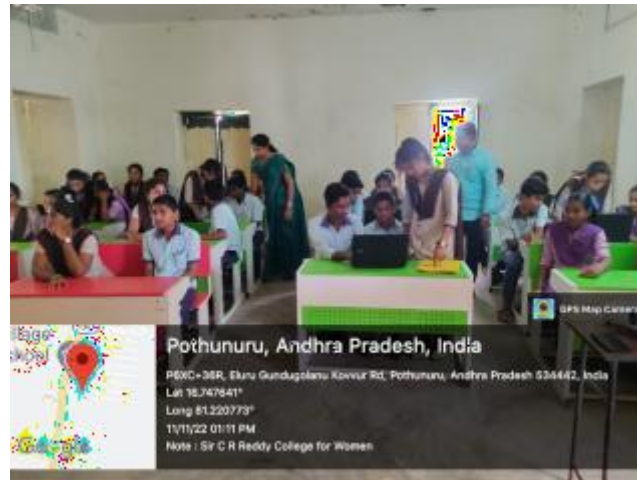
