- ✓ It is a system that begins to consider potential environmental and social impacts by eliminating the use of synthetic inputs,
- ✓ Such as synthetic fertilizers and pesticides, veterinary drugs, genetically modified seeds and breeds, preservatives, additives and irradiation.
- ✓ These are replaced with site-specific management practices that maintain and increase long-term soil fertility and prevent pest and diseases.
