

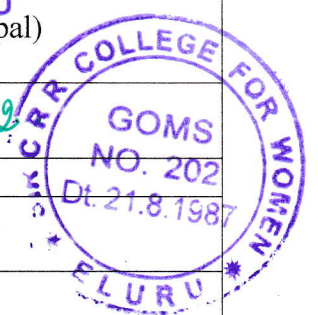

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into on this 19th day of June, 2022 by and between **Sir C R Reddy College for Women, Eluru** (First party) and **Sheelu Hair International Pvt Ltd., Eluru** (Second party). **Sir C R Reddy College for Women** and **Sheelu Hair International Pvt Ltd., Eluru** agree that cooperation in research collaborations and student and faculty exchanges would be mutually beneficial. The areas of cooperation may include, subject to mutual consent, any desirable and feasible activity that would further support the goals of each institution. Such interaction may include cooperation in a variety of joint academic and educational activities such as:

- *Training on Business –to - Consumer (B2C), Consumer –to – Consumer (C2C), Consumer-to – Business (C2B), Business – to – Administration (B2A) activities which includes the operation of
 - i. *Buying, selling products online and marketing*
 - ii. *Online ticketing, online payment, Drop shipping*
 - iii. *Online accounting software, online customer support**
- *Students projects and publications, including work by undergraduate students at the partner institutions;*
- *Faculty and student exchanges based on reciprocity;*
- *Internships and Field projects on online marketing strategies*
- *Organizing Training programmes/ OJT etc.*
- *Visits by faculty, and students for experiential learning.*
- *Support for invited talks / Guest lecturers etc on online Business modules.*

The parties anticipate that a number of these initiatives will occur during the period of this MOU. However, neither party is obligated to agree to any minimum number of activities, nor is this MOU intended to preclude either party from entering into similar agreements with other institutions.

This MOU shall be identified as the parent document of any program agreement executed between the parties. Further agreements concerning any program shall provide details concerning the specific commitments made by each party and shall not become effective

until they have been reduced to writing, executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties.

In order to facilitate student exchanges between **Sheelu Hair International Pvt Ltd., Eluru** and **Sir C R Reddy College for Women, Eluru** the following section provides general procedural information under which the exchange of students between the two institutions will take place.

Cooperation and exchanges may take place with undergraduate, students & faculty. Each exchange may be for the duration of one academic year, one academic semester, or one intensive course, normally three or four weeks in length, scheduled either between academic terms or during the summer.

Students may be engaged for internship opportunities by the host institution, providing they meet the internship criteria specified by regulatory authorities.

Responsibilities of home institution for academic semester or academic year exchanges:

The home institution will:

- Register its own students for the duration of the exchange.
- Submit to the host institution the names and academic credentials of students who would like to participate in an exchange.
- Provide the host institution with names of courses that are essential to their own students' curricular plan.
- Ask the student to advise the host institution of any circumstances that may affect his or her year abroad (e.g. medical condition, disability status).

Responsibilities of the host institution for academic semester or academic year exchanges:

The host institution will:

- Be responsible for students recommended by the home institution.
- Provide an orientation program for incoming students.
- Endeavor to ensure that students admitted to the courses regarded as essential to their academic programs at their home institutions.
- Assign an academic advisor to all incoming students.
- Assist the incoming student in all kinds of academic assistance
- Inform the incoming student of health insurance requirements if necessary.
- Provide the home institution with a final transcript of the student's academic performance.

Short term intensive courses:

Short term intensive courses, offered during the summer or between semesters, will be taught by a faculty member from either **Sir C R Reddy College for Women** or **Sheelu Hair International Pvt Ltd.**

Students will bear the cost of:

- Their own health insurance and any medical bills or non-mandatory fees;
- Food, living expenses, and any other costs relating to the exchange;
- Books and necessary academic supplies necessary for the course.

The number of credit hours each student will earn will depend on the nature and length of the course and by the department/faculty offering the course.

The primary contacts for this MOU are **Sheelu Hair International Pvt Ltd.** and Convener **Industry Institute Interaction cell of Sir C R Reddy College for Women**. As previously noted, the parties shall enter into specific written agreements whenever appropriate to clarify and define the nature, extent, and terms of operation for the proposed collaborations, including intellectual property ownership and funding issues. Any agreement entered into by these two institutions will require the approval of appropriate officers from each institution. All agreements and activities covered under this MOU or entered into by the parties must comply with all applicable laws and regulations.

For agreed upon activities, both institutions will make available their facilities and staffs. This MOU will take effect on and will be valid for **three (3) years** from the date noted in the first line of this document unless terminated by one of the parties. Either party may withdraw from this MOU provided written notification of the withdrawal is given to the other party at least **three (3) months** prior to the desired withdrawal date. This MOU may be renewed for another period of **three (3) years** upon mutual written consent of the parties before the expiration date. Each institution will have copies of this agreement.

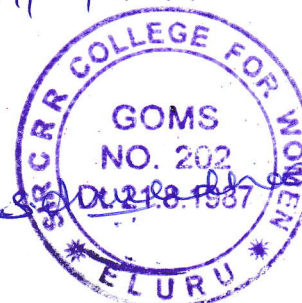

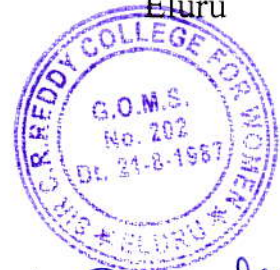

“Sir C R Reddy College for Women, Eluru” THE FIRST PARTY represented herein by its **Principal** (here in after referred as '**First Party**', the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

AND

Cloud Mellow Technologies, Eluru West Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh, (here in after referred to as "**Second Party**"), the company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns.

(First Party and Second Party are here in after jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party') as

WHERE AS:

- A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:
Sir C R Reddy College for Women, Eluru
- B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- C) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.
- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.
- E) **Cloud Mellow Technologies,** the Second Party is engaged in Business, Skill Development, Education and R&D Services
- F) **Cloud Mellow Technologies,** the Second Party will be supporting the undertaking of the course.
- G) Give related information, its branches, and dimensional information about the industry concerned with whom the MoU is sworn.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the **Sir C R Reddy College for Women, Eluru** and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.

1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MOU

The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

Curriculum Design: Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably for value added and certificate courses of the curriculum so that the students and faculty to empower them and fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.

Industrial Training & Visits: Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight in to the latest developments / requirements of the industries; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its group companies and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The

industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide its Labs / Workshops / Industrial Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.

Skill Development Programs: Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.

Guest Lectures: Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.

- *Support for invited talks / Guest lecturers etc.*

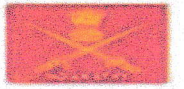

specific commitments made by each party and shall not become effective until they have been reduced to writing, executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties.

In order to facilitate student exchanges between **Chitturi Plants & Pots, Eluru** and **Sir C R Reddy College for Women, Eluru** the following section provides general procedural information under which the exchange of students between the two institutions will take place.

Cooperation and exchanges may take place with undergraduate, students & faculty. Each exchange may be for the duration of one academic year, one academic semester, or one intensive course, normally three or four weeks in length, scheduled either between academic terms or during the summer.

Students may be engaged for internship opportunities by the host institution, providing they meet the internship criteria specified by regulatory authorities.

Responsibilities of home institution for academic semester or academic year exchanges:

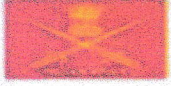
The home institution will:

- Register its own students for the duration of the exchange.
- Submit to the host institution the names and academic credentials of students who would like to participate in an exchange.
- Provide the host institution with names of courses that are essential to their own students' curricular plan.
- Ask the student to advise the host institution of any circumstances that may affect his or her year abroad (e.g. medical condition, disability status).

Responsibilities of the host institution for academic semester or academic year exchanges:

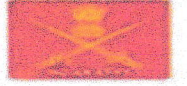
The host institution will:

- Be responsible for students recommended by the home institution.
- Provide an orientation program for incoming students.
- Endeavor to ensure that students admitted to the courses regarded as essential to their academic programs at their home institutions.

Short term intensive courses, offered during the summer or between semesters, will be taught by a faculty member from either **Sir C R Reddy College for Women** or **Chitturi Plants & Pots, Eluru**

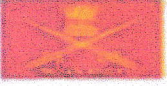
Students will bear the cost of:

- Their own health insurance and any medical bills or non-mandatory fees;
- Food, living expenses, and any other costs relating to the exchange;
- Books and necessary academic supplies necessary for the course.

The number of credit hours each student will earn will depend on the nature and length of the course and by the department/faculty offering the course.

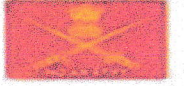
The primary contacts for this MOU are **Chitturi Plants & Pots, Eluru** and Convener **Industry Institute Interaction cell** of **Sir C R Reddy College for Women**. As previously noted, the parties shall enter into specific written agreements whenever appropriate to clarify and define the nature, extent, and terms of operation for the proposed collaborations, including intellectual property ownership and funding issues. Any agreement entered into by these two institutions will require the approval of appropriate officers from each institution. All agreements and activities covered under this MOU or entered into by the parties must comply with all applicable laws and regulations.

For agreed upon activities, both institutions will make available their facilities and staffs. This MOU will take effect on and will be valid for **three (3) years** from the date noted in the first line of this document unless terminated by one of the parties. Either party may withdraw from this MOU provided written notification of the withdrawal is given to the other party at least **three(3) months** prior to the desired withdrawal date. This MOU may be renewed for another period of **three(3) years** upon mutual written consent of the parties before the expiration date. Each institution will have copies of this agreement.

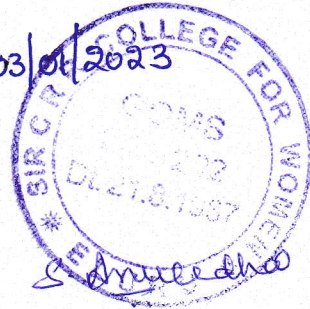

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

Whereas:

- A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution (HEI) named SIR C.R.REDDY COLLEGE FOR WOMEN, Eluru, Eluru Dist, Andhra Pradesh, offering a wide range of programs in UG and PG in science especially in chemistry combination
- B) Second Party, ACTIVE PHARMA LABS, Raja Enclave (2nd Floor, #202), KPHB Colony, Hyderabad, Telangana-500072, is a premier pharmaceutical institute of education and technology offering fully integrated hands-on training in pharmaceutical sciences, technology and regulatory compliance. Active Pharma Labs provides and confers pharmaceutical skills certification to university and college graduates who have completed its programs and fulfilled the standards of professional excellence.
- C) The First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- D) The Parties in Toto cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within the area of Skill Based Training, Hands on Training in concern subject or education, Placement Assistance and Research and Development in domain subject including sharing of infrastructure for research and expertise in the related fields.
- E) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves, desire to sign this MoU to advance their mutual interests.

of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another. First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the professional faculty/staff of Second Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable technical/training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry.

The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MoU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated interms of this MoU. CLAUSE-2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance the skills and knowledge in the following areas.

Curriculum Design: Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in curriculum design and development, revision of syllabi, introduction of new courses, practical and training methodology so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.

Industrial Training & Visits: Institution and Industry interaction will give an insight into the latest developments / requirements of both the institutions; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First party to visit the pharmaceutical labs and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to industry. Guest Lectures: Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lecturers to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in-house requirements.

Faculty Development Programs: Second Party to train the Faculties of First Party for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.

Placement of Trained Students: Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the training and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs; and will facilitate placements for the students. The Second Party will itself absorb the trained students.

Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmes on the terms specified herein.

There is no financial commitment on the part of ACTIVE PHARMA LABS, Raja Enclave (2nd Floor, #202), KPHB Colony, Hyderabad, Telangana-500072 take up any programme mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt with separately.

CLAUSE-3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Nothing contained in this MoU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copyrights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE-4: VALIDITY

This Agreement will be valid for three years from the date of agreement until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period ACTIVE PHARMA LABS, Raja Enclave (2nd Floor, #202), KPHB Colony, Hyderabad, Telangana-500072, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MoU. Any act on the part of ACTIVE PHARMA LABS, Raja Enclave (2nd Floor, #202), KPHB Colony, Hyderabad, Telangana-500072 the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MoU. Both Parties may terminate this MoU upon 30 calendar days notice in writing. In the even to after termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

CLAUSE-5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

It is expressly agreed that Sir C.R.Reddy College for Women, Eluru, Eluru District, Andhra Pradesh and, ACTIVE PHARMA LABS, Raja Enclave (2nd Floor, #202), KPHB Colony, Hyderabad, Telangana-500072 are acting under this MoU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in anyway, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

Sir C.R.Reddy College for Women, Eluru was established at Vatluru village, Eluru during 1987 to cater to the educational needs of the girl students of the rural areas, as a part of women empowerment. The College has been offering major groups in Commerce, Computers and Science with important combinations. (hereinafter referred to as **CRR College for Women, Eluru**) of the other part.

1.1.2 **WHEREAS** ICAR-Indian Institute of Oil Palm Research, Pedavegi – 534 450, Andhra Pradesh - is the India's premier institute for oil palm research having scientific staff with specializations in Agronomy, Plant Breeding, Horticulture, Seed Technology, Plant Protection, Plant Physiology, Social Sciences, Computer sciences, etc. These scientists are well trained in their field in India. There are several prestigious ongoing activities/ projects at the IIOPR.


1.1.3 **WHEREAS** Sir C.R.Reddy College for Women, Eluru is a college offering educational courses such as under graduation and post graduation in science, commerce, computers, etc.

1.2 PREAMBLE

It is, therefore, proposed to extend collaborative efforts between ICAR-Indian Institute of Oil Palm Research, Pedavegi (hereinafter referred to as IIOPR, Pedavegi), which has well-equipped laboratories having most modern scientific instruments/ facilities and also excellent physical and technical facility for doing research on oil palm with that of Sir C.R.Reddy College for Women, Eluru (hereinafter referred to as CRR College for Women, Eluru), which is having adequate facilities in undergraduate and post graduate teaching and research.

For jointly undertaking undergraduate and postgraduate education research and training with the following terms and conditions applicable to both ICAR-Indian Institute of Oil Palm Research, Pedavegi (hereinafter referred to as IIOPR, Pedavegi) and Sir C.R.Reddy College for Women, Eluru (hereinafter referred to as CRR College for Women, Eluru).

1.3 OBJECTIVE

The objective of the Memorandum of Understanding will be to promote quality research and training in cutting edge areas by facilitating students to seek specialized guidance and facilities of ICAR Research Institutes.

1.4 SCOPE

The guidelines will be uniform across entire ICAR-AU system and applicable only to those institutions where there exists a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the ICAR Research Institutes and the University/ Deemed - to - be - University (DU) seeking collaboration. The University/ DU may be within National Agricultural Research System (AUs/ ICAR DUs) or outside NARS (Central/ State Govt/ Public sector funded Institutions/ State Universities/ PSU/ Autonomous bodies/ Statutory corporations/ Private Universities or Institutions). The research carried out has to promote the major function of the Institute.

2. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

2.1 GENERAL

1. The students and staff (regular or contractual) from CRR College for Women, Eluru, as well as JRFs/SRFs/RAs/other staff (regular or contractual) working at IIOPR, Pedavegi desiring to undertake research work fully or partially at IIOPR, Pedavegi will have to get the application recommended from faculty members of the IIOPR, Pedavegi, as per ICAR guidelines.
2. The CRR College for Women, Eluru, shall offer degrees to JRFs/SRFs/RAs/ and other staff (regular or contractual) working at the IIOPR, Pedavegi who fulfilling the educational qualifications as per the rules and regulations of the CRR College for Women, Eluru, with respect to intake of student.
3. The College shall be responsible for realization of all fee and dues from the students enrolling for degree and maintenance of all the records pertaining to the degree required.
4. IIOPR, Pedavegi shall offer students and staff (regular or contractual) from CRR College for Women, Eluru to carry out research work at IIOPR, Pedavegi as per the mandate of IIOPR, Pedavegi and ICAR guidelines.

5. The field and laboratory facilities will be shared by both the organizations on mutually agreed term basis, as per ICAR guidelines.
6. A faculty member of any ICAR research institute could admit the student(s) directly for research work with the prior approval of the Head of the Institution, as per ICAR guidelines.
7. The number of students allocated to the Major Advisor/Major Guide normally may not exceed two at a given time, irrespective of the nature of degree programme (Master's or Doctoral). However, Director of the Institute may decide and take final decision in this regard based on the requirement, available manpower and research infrastructure.
8. The partnering institute(s) are expected to make reasonable contribution in the form of intellectual input to the student's research problem and may not merely serve as a source of providing samples/ facilities for the study.

2.2 SPECIFIC CONDITIONS FOR ORGANISATIONS (Central/State Govt./Public sector funded Institutions /State Universities/PSU/Autonomous Bodies/Statutory bodies/ Private Universities or Institutions)

A. Advisor/ Guide

- (i) The criterion for allocation of Major Guide/ Advisor will primarily be governed by the intellectual input and time duration devoted for carrying out the research work at a particular institution.
- (ii) The Memorandum of Understanding also envisages that the JRFs/SRFs/RAs/ and other staff (regular or contractual) working at IIOPR, Pedavegi enrolled for Post Graduate/ Ph. D with the CRR College for Women, Eluru, will be assigned Major Advisor from the IIOPR, Pedavegi and the Co-Advisor from CRR College for Women, Eluru, (as envisaged in ICAR guidelines).
- (iii) The student desiring to work at IIOPR, Pedavegi will have to select problem/area of research as per the mandate of IIOPR. One of the scientists in concerned/related discipline from IIOPR, Pedavegi will act as a Major-Advisor or Co- Advisor.
- (iv) The students in consultation with Major advisor and Co- Advisor can carry out his/her research work fully or partially at IIOPR, Pedavegi or CRR College for Women, Eluru, depending upon the facilities available and as per ICAR guidelines.
- (v) The objective(s) for research work for a student coming from such an institution should be exclusively different as far as possible.

B. Fee Structure

The students shall be uniformly charged a fee of Rs. 20,000/- for training / research/ dissertation up to duration of three months and @ Rs. 30,000/- per semester for the work exceeding three months.

The fee structure will be reviewed periodically after two years by the Institute. The fee payment is to be made to IIOPR before the commencement of each semester (six months or three months).

C. Publications

- (i) The students would invariably be the senior author for the publications arising out of the research work conducted at the Institute, followed by Major Guide/ Advisor and Co-Major Advisor/Co-Guide in that order.
- (ii) In the publications on the research work carried at IIOPR, the Guide identified at the IIOPR will be the second author. The names of additional co-authors, depending upon their contribution in the research work, may be decided by mutual consent between the student and major Guide/ Advisor.
- (iii) The partnering institution ensures that the students submit at least one paper from Master's thesis and two papers from Ph. D thesis before thesis submission in order to prevent students leaving the Institute(s) without publishing any research publication from the thesis.

D. Intellectual Property Rights (IPRs)


The student will be expected to protect the Intellectual Property Rights generated or likely to be generated during his/her research work. The IPRs shall rest with the Indian Institute of Oil Palm Research/Indian Council of Agricultural Research. Patents/protections/knowledge generated will be shared in proportion as per the 'ICAR Guidelines for Intellectual Property Management and Technology Transfer /Commercialization' as amended from time to time.

2.3. FORCE MAJEURE

2.3.1. Neither party shall be held responsible for non-fulfillment of their respective obligations under this agreement due to the exigency of one or more of the *force majeure* events such as but not limited to Acts of God, war, flood, earthquakes, strike, lockouts, epidemics, riots, civil commotion, etc. provided on the occurrence and cessation of any such events, the party affected thereby shall give a notice in writing to the other party within one month of such occurrence or cessation. If the *force majeure* conditions continue beyond six months, the parties shall then mutually decide about the future course of action.

2.4. EFFECTIVE DATE, DURATION, TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT


- 2.4.1 The agreement shall be effective from May 01, 2023 and shall remain in force for a period of 36 months from the said date.
- 2.4.2 The agreement shall be deemed to expire on completion of the period, as in provision 2.4.1 unless extended by both the parties.
- 2.4.3 During the tenure of the agreement, parties hereto can terminate the agreement either for breach of any of the terms and conditions of this agreement or otherwise by giving a [2 months] notice in writing to the defaulting party. Failure of either party to terminate the agreement on account of breach or default by other shall not constitute a waiver of that party's right to terminate this agreement.
- 2.4.4 In the event of termination of the agreement vide provision 2.4.3 the rights and obligations of the parties thereto shall be settled by mutual discussion; the financial settlement shall take into consideration not only the expenditure incurred but also the expenditure committed by COUNCIL/INSTITUTE, as per ICAR guidelines.
- 2.4.5 In the event of termination of agreement, the CONTRACTING PARTY shall not be entitled for refund of contact fee paid in advance to COUNCIL/INSTITUTE
- 2.4.6 The agreement arrived at between the parties hereto for utilization of intellectual property shall survive the termination of the agreement.

2.5 NOTICES

2.5.1. All notices and other communications required to be served on the CONTRACTING PARTY under the terms of this agreement, shall be considered to be duly served if the same shall have been delivered to, left with or posted by registered mail to the CONTRACTING PARTY at its last known address. Similarly, any notice to be given to the COUNCIL shall be considered as duly served if the same shall have been delivered to, left with or posted by registered mail to the INSTITUTE at its registered address at PEDAVEGI.

2.6 AMENDMENTS OF THE AGREEMENT

2.6.1. No amendment or modification of this agreement shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of this agreement. The modifications/ changes shall be effective from the date on which they are made/ executed, unless otherwise agreed to.


