MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called as the 'MoU' is entered into the force from 1st JUNE, 2021 by and between SIR C R REDDY COLLEGE FOR WOMEN-ELURU, Eluru Dist, Andhra Pradesh (THE FIRST PARTY) represented herein by its Principal (hereinafter referred as 'First Party' the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors-in-office, administrators and assigns) and **MONVI LABORATORIES Pvt. Ltd., Plot No:95 & 96, ALEAP, Gajularamaram, Hyderabad, Telangana** represented herein by its executive head, Director (here in after referred to as "Second Party", institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors-in-office, administrators and assigns). (First Party and Second Party are here in after jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

Whereas:

- A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution (HEI) named Sir C.R.Reddy College for women, Eluru, Eluru Dist, Andhra Pradesh, offering a wide range of programs in UG and PG in science especially in chemistry combination
- B) Second Party, **MONVI LABORATORIES Pvt. Ltd., Plot No:95 & 96, ALEAP, Gajularamaram, Hyderabad, Telangana**, offers wide range of services in the areas like synthetic organic chemistry, organic synthesis, medicinal chemistry, research and development, analytical research and development, API and formulations. It provides and confers pharmaceutical skills certification to university and college graduates who have completed its programs and fulfilled the standards of professional excellence
- C) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- D) The Parties in Toto cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within the area of Skill Based Training, Hands on Training in concern subject or education, Placement Assistance and Research and Development in domain subject including sharing of infrastructure for research and expertise in the related fields
- E) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MoU for advancing their mutual interests.

Now therefore, in consideration of the mutual promises set for then this MoU, the parties here to agree as follows

CLAUSE-1: CO-OPERATION

Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote

and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another. First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the professional faculty/staff of Second Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable technical/training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry.

The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MoU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MoU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter here of and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE-2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an institution. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance the skills and knowledge in the following areas.

Curriculum Design: Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in curriculum design and development, revision of syllabi, introduction of new courses, practical and training methodology so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.

Industrial Training & Visits: Institution and Industry interaction will give an insight in to the latest developments / requirements of both the institutions; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First party to visit the pharmaceutical labs and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to industry. The Second Party will provide its Laboratory facilities/ Workshops /Industrial Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.

Research and Development: Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of chemistry, pharmacy and other aliened areas including like sharing of infrastructure for research.

Skill Development Programs: Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make

them industry ready.

Guest Lectures: Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lecturers to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.

Faculty Development Programs: Second Party to train the Faculties of First Party for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.

Placement of Trained Students: Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the training and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs; and will facilitate placements for the students. The Second Party will itself absorb the trained students. Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the programmes on the terms specified herein

There is no financial commitment on the part of **MONVI LABORATORIES Pvt. Ltd., Plot No:95 & 96, ALEAP, Gajularamaram, Hyderabad, Telangana** take up any programmes mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

CLAUSE-3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Nothing contained in this MoU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copyrights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE-4: VALIDITY

This Agreement will be valid for three years from the date of agreement until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period **MONVI LABORATORIES Pvt. Ltd., Plot No:95 & 96, ALEAP, Gajularamaram, Hyderabad, Telangana** the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MoU. Any act on the part of **MONVI LABORATORIES Pvt. Ltd., Plot No:95 & 96, ALEAP, Gajularamaram, Hyderabad, Telangana** the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MoU. Both Parties may terminate this MoU upon 30 calendar days notice in writing. In the even to after termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

It is expressly agreed that Sir C.R.Reddy College for women, Eluru, Eluru Dist, Andhra Pradesh and, **MONVI LABORATORIES Pvt. Ltd., Plot**

No:95 & 96, ALEAP, Gajularamaram, Hyderabad, Telangana are acting under this MoU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in anyway, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. 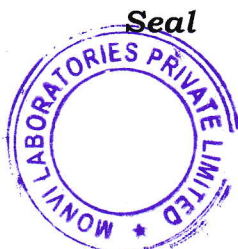

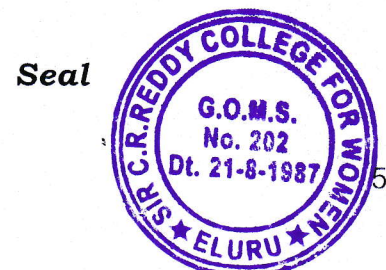

The areas of cooperation may include, subject to mutual consent, any desirable and feasible activity that would further support the goals of each institution. Such interaction may include cooperation in a variety of joint academic and educational activities such as:

- *Examining company accounts and financial control systems*
- *Checking and analyzing spread sheet data*
- *Checking the financial report and accuracy and reliability of records*
- *Ensuring protection of Assets*
- *Preparing reports (IT reports, financial report etc)*
- *Presenting findings and recommendations*
- *Ensuring procedures, policies legislation and regulations are correctly followed and complied with*
- *Reviews of wages*

The parties anticipate that a number of these initiatives will occur during the period of this MoU. However, neither party is obligated to agree to any minimum number of activities, nor is this MoU intended to preclude either party from entering into similar agreements with other institutions.

This MoU shall be identified as the parent document of any program agreement executed between the parties. Further agreements concerning any program shall provide details concerning the specific commitments made by each party and shall not become effective until they have been reduced to writing, executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties.

In order to facilitate student exchanges between **M/S Mallikharjuna K Rao & Co., Chartered Accountants, Eluru** and **Sir C R Reddy College for Women, Eluru** the following section provides general procedural information under which the exchange of students between the two institutions will take place.

Cooperation and exchanges may take place with undergraduates, students & faculty. Each exchange may be for the duration of one academic year, one academic semester, or one intensive course, normally three or four weeks in length, scheduled either between academic terms or during the summer.

Students may be engaged for internship opportunities by the host institution, providing they meet the internship criteria specified by regulatory authorities.

Responsibilities of home institution for academic semester or academic year exchanges:

The home institution will:

- Register its own students for the duration of the exchange.
- Submit to the host institution the names and academic credentials of students who would like to participate in an exchange.
- Provide the host institution with names of courses that are essential to their own students' curricular plan.
- Ask the student to advise the host institution of any circumstances that may affect his or her year abroad (e.g. medical condition, disability status).
- Be responsible for students recommended by the home institution.
- Provide an orientation program for incoming students.
- Endeavor to ensure that students admitted to the courses regarded as essential to their academic programs at their home institutions.
- Assign an academic advisor to all incoming students.
- Assist the incoming student in all kinds of academic assistance
- Inform the incoming student of health insurance requirements if necessary.
- Provide the home institution with a final transcript of the student's academic performance.

Short term intensive courses:

Short term intensive courses, offered during the summer or between semesters, will be taught by a faculty member from either **Sir C R Reddy College for Women** or **M/S Mallikharjuna K Rao & Co., Chartered Accountants, Eluru**.

Students will bear the cost of:


- Their own health insurance and any medical bills or non-mandatory fees;
- Food, living expenses, and any other costs relating to the exchange;
- Books and necessary academic supplies necessary for the course.

The number of credit hours each student will earn will depend on the nature and length of the course and by the department/faculty offering the course.

The primary contacts for this MoU are **Mallikharjuna K Rao & Co., Chartered Accountants, Eluru.** and Convener **Industry Institute Interaction cell of Sir C R Reddy College for Women.** As previously noted, the parties shall enter into specific written agreements whenever appropriate to clarify and define the nature, extent, and terms of operation for the proposed collaborations, including intellectual property ownership and funding issues.
