

The parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperative within area of skill based training, Educational and research.

D)Both the parties being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.

E)Sir C R Reddy College For Women , the second party is engaged in academics , Surveys , skill development , Education and R&D services.

F)Sir C R Reddy College For Women —the second party promoted by Sir C R Reddy Educational institutions ,Eluru , and represented by the principal , Sir C R Reddy College , has been actively working for the last 35 years.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS.

CLAUSE-1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both parties are united by common interests and objectives , and they shall establish channels of communication and cooperation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the institution and its related wings. The parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information they may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 The general terms of cooperation shall be governed by this MOU. The parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents ('the definitive documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of definitive documents shall be mutually decided between the parties. Along with the definitive document, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE-2 SCOPE OF THE MOU

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological upgraduation innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close cooperation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 CIRRCULUM DESIGN: Second party will give valuable inputs to the first party in teaching/training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 2.3INDUSTRIAL TRAINING AND VISITS: Industry and institutions interaction will give an insight into the latest developments/requirements of the industries; the second party to permit the faculty and students of the first party to visit its group companies and also involve in industrial training programs for the first party. The industrial training and exposure provided to student and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career .The second party will provide its labs / workshops/ industrial sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the first party.

- 2.6 GUEST LECTURES: Second party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lecturers to the student of the first party on the technology trends and in-house requirements.

- 2.7 FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS: Second party to train the faculty of the party for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the national occupational standards in concern sector, if available.
- 2.8 PLACEMENT OF TRAINED STUDENTS: Second part will actively engage to help the delivery of the training and placement of students of the first party into internships/jobs; and will facilitate placements for at least 50% of the train students.
- 2.9 Both parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the programs on the terms specified herein.
- 2.10 There is no financial commitment on the part of the SKSD MAHILA KALASALA, the first party to take up any program mentioned in the MOU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately .

CLAUSE-3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall , by express grant , implication , estoppels or otherwise , create in either party any right , title interest , or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know- how ,inventions patents , copy rights and designs)of the other party

CLAUSE-4 VALIDITY

4.1 This agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either party on mutually agreed terms, during which period Sir C R Reddy College For Women , the second party , as the case may be , will take effective steps her implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of training partner or Sir C R Reddy College the second party after terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days notice in writing. In the event of termination , both parties have to discharge their obligations.

CLAUSE-5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES
