

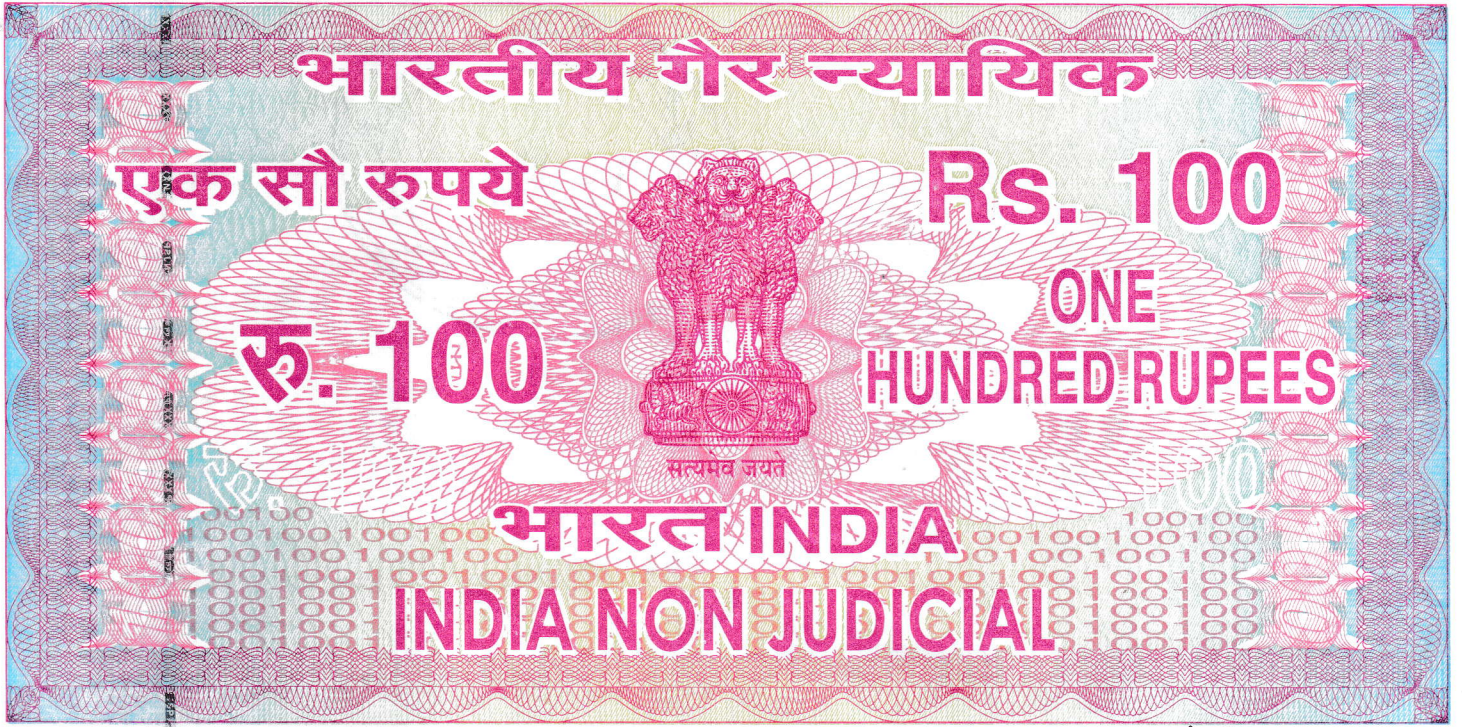

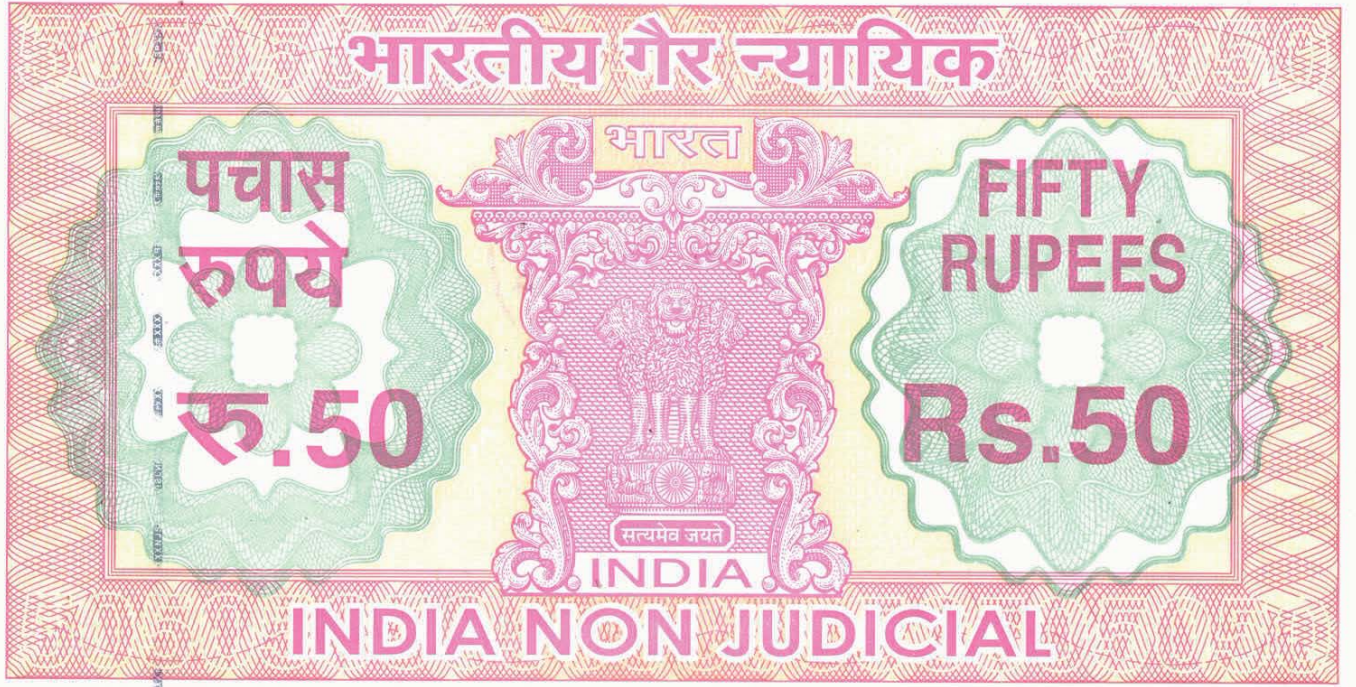

C) The parties intend to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperative within area of skill based training, Educational and research.

D) Both the parties being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.

F) Sir C R Reddy College For Women - the second party promoted by Sir C R Reddy Educational institutions, Eluru, and represented by the principal, Sir C R Reddy College, has been actively working for the last 35 years.

NOW THEREFORE ,IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS.

CLAUSE-1

CO-OPERATION

1.1 Both parties are united by common interests and objectives , and they shall establish channels of communication and cooperation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the institution and its related wings. The parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information they may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

1.2 The general terms of cooperation shall be governed by this MOU. The parties shall cooperate with each other and shall , as promptly as is reasonably practical , enter into all relevant agreements , deeds and documents('the definitive documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of definitive documents shall be mutually decided between the parties. Along with the definitive document , this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE-2

SCOPE OF THE MOU

2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-graduation innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close cooperation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

2.2 CURRICULUM DESIGN: Second party will give valuable inputs to the first party in teaching/training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.

2.3 INDUSTRIAL TRAINING AND VISITS: Industry and institutions interaction will give an insight into the latest developments/requirements of the industries; the second party to permit the faculty and students of the first party to visit its group companies and also involve in industrial training programs for the first party. 

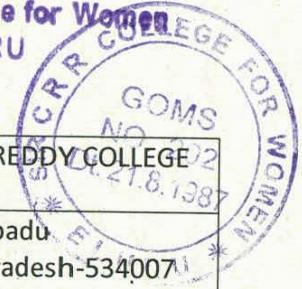


