Major Practices based on Environment, Energy and Waste Audit:

Energy Conservation

- · Purchased energy-saving appliances to conserve energy in the science departments
- Annual check-ups on the gadgets are done to improve their efficiency.
- CFL lamps and filament lamps are replaced with LED bulbs through KSEB's energy saving program.
- Awareness is given to staff and students to unplug and turn off electrical appliances when not in use or after use.

Water Audit

- Water coolers installed in all departments
- Periodic water quality assessment is done as part of the internal and external audit
- For re-strengthening the existing water management practices, awareness programmes are given periodically and also posters displayed for the same in the campus.
- . High quality pipes for collecting waste water from the labs are installed
- Chlorination of main water sources is done regularly

Waste Audit

- Health Checkup and Health Awareness class organized for support staff
- Periodic appraisal of different kinds of waste and its quantified data are collected for the effective waste management in the campus.
- A waste management committee is established comprising the Principal, Vice
 Principal, Manger, two faculty coordinators and two student representatives
- Construction and Demolition wastes are handed over to merchants for reuse of the materials and for proper disposal.
- Organic manure produced from the biogas and vermi compost are used for farming and horticulture in the hostel premises.

- Management is paying much attention to the effective implementation of green protocols in the campus.
- Color-coded waste bins are kept for the waste segregation
- Electronic wastes and hazardous wastes are handed over to authorized waste
 collection centers that are approved by Andhra pardesh State Pollution Board
- In order to popularize Waste Management themes, days and years of importance are celebrated and various campaigns are undertaken by departments, cells and clubs of the college.

Biodiversity Audit

- Various native trees are planted inside the campus. Periodic monitoring and removal of alien and invasive species enhances restoration of native and wetland species.

- Garden wastes out of trimming are put in the bio gas plant.
