Awareness programme On ROAD SAFETY

The NSS wing of Sir C R Reddy College for Women, Eluru organized a programme on "Administering Road Safety is every ones Responsibility". Degree students and some of the staff were participated in this programme on 12\2\24 at 11:30AM.For this awareness programme the guest speakers were shri K.V.S Prasad, Motor Vehicle Inspector ShriG.Prasad ,Motor Vehicle Inspector Correspondent Shri. Chalasani Viswanadham garu, Smt.P.Sailaja, Principal.The chief guest illustrated that every year road crashes result in loss of lakhs of lives andserious injuries to cores of people. In India itself about 80000 people were killed in road crashes every year which is thirteen percent of the total fatality all over the world .Man behind the wheel plays an important role in most of the crashes.He gave some road safety tips while driving

- Always adhere to speed limits.
- Take special care about children, senior citizens, and pedestrians.
- Don't drive if tired.
- Always observe and anticipate other road users.
- Don't try to multi task.
- Slow down your speed if you watch people crossing a street.
- If you are driving in a bad weather or foggy area, where visibility is restricted, it is good to slow down considerably.
- Be very careful while driving in school areas, hospitals, road intersections and main road Junctions where you observe increased mobility of children and people.
- While turning make sure you have slowed down and you are giving proper space to the Pedestrians
- For crossing road turns are very dangerous as drivers often lose their control while turning fast.

For Pedestrians:

- Carry flash lights during night or if you are going to cross roads where there is scarcity of light.
- Avoid running across the street. It can create a sense of driving distraction for the driver leading to more severe accidents. More over if you trip while running, the situation can get out of hand.

- Ensure that you are aware of traffic signal signs and traffic symbols.
- If you don't find cross walks or zebra crossing, wait till the traffic signal is red. Don't take unnecessary risk by jumping in busy traffic.
- Be careful while crossing high speed roads and multiple road junctions.

Traffic safety tips for Kids:

Do not take your head or hands out of Moving vehicle. This can cause accidents and can hurt you badly. So make sure that you never ever do it and also ask your friends not to do it in future. Also make sure that you enter the bus and exit the bus only when it has stopped completely. Avoid playing in a moving bus as it can hurt you.

The guest speaker said that Teachers should help develop a responsible attitude towards road use in college. The Teachers should ensure that the children enter and leave the college safely. The vehicles including college buses are parked safely and properly, the students should be supervised and taken care of at the time of alighting and boarding the college bus.

He concludes the session by saying parents must ensure that the children acquire the right knowledge and skills for safe use of roads. They should teach their children the basic rules of the road. How to alight and board a bus etc.
