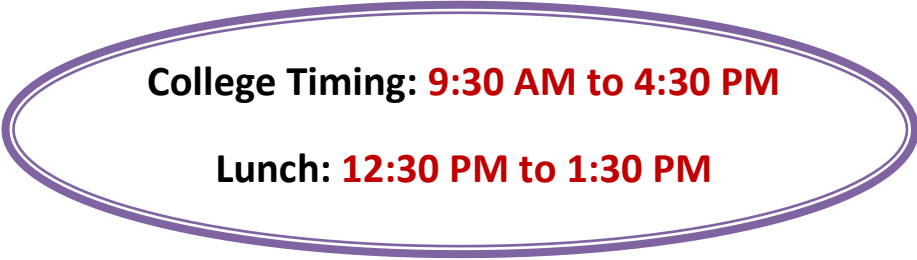
Principal

Working Hours



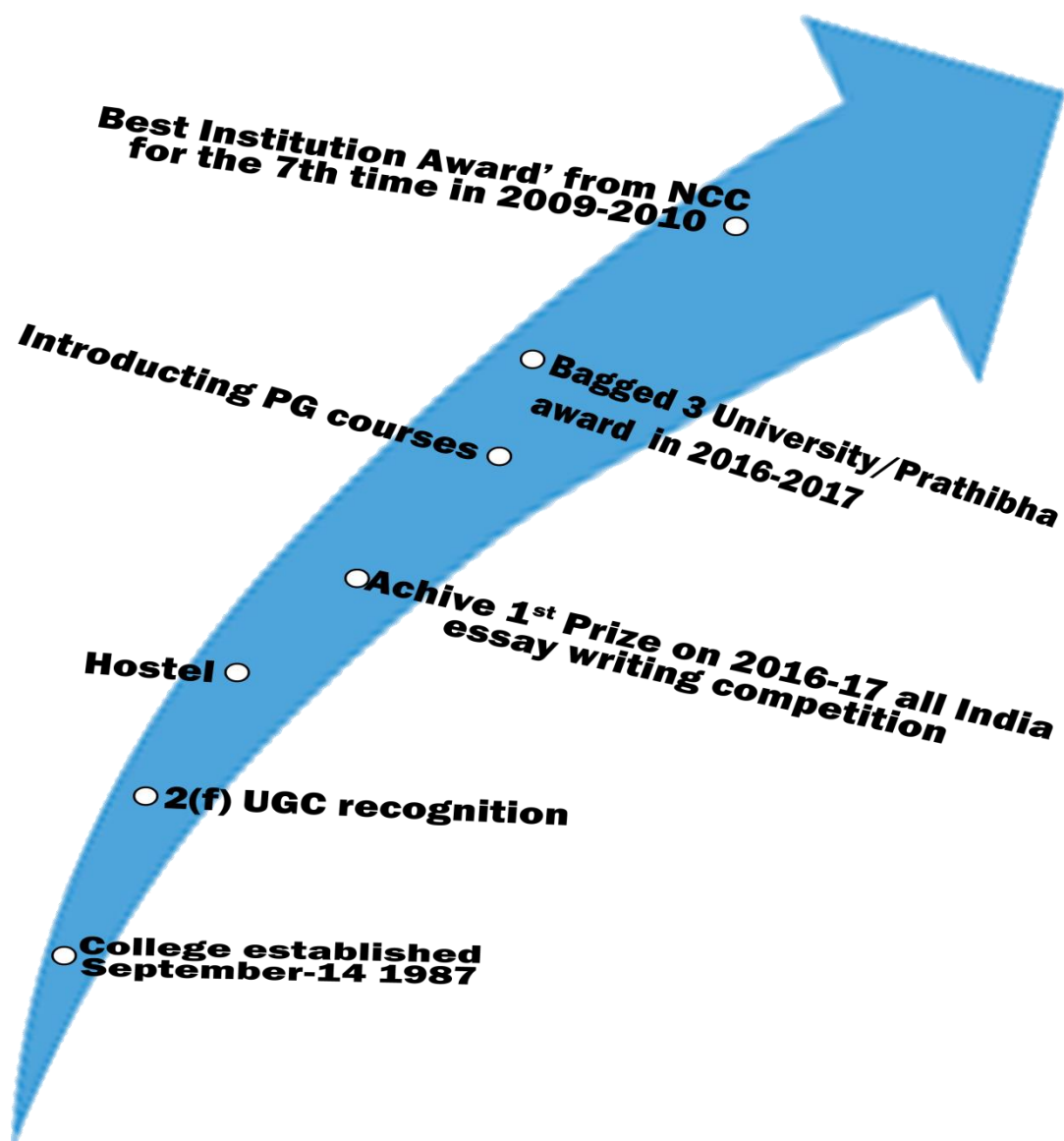
College Timing: 9:30 AM to 4:30 PM

Infrastructural Facilities

A sprawling campus of 23 acres of the college comprises of the following infrastructural facilities to enhance and promote an ambient academic atmosphere.

Student Support

To mould the prime state holder (The student) towards holistic development & facilitate to attend the intuition the following facilities have been extended

Bus facility - They are 12 college buses to collect the student for neiberhood station and reached the student intuition safely. This also help the student to communicate among themselves exchange of ideas, togetherness, team work, help each other for many requirements a nominal monthly bus fee is collected based on **“NO PROFIT - NO LOSS”**

Hostel – Located in the campus providing accommodation for 450 students. The students after getting admission, if they want hostel admission, a separate form to be field in by paying prescribed hostel fee by the management

The students are provided with academic menities besides Health check up & Medical facility and tutorial study hours under the supervision of facility. Recreational and leisure time facilities- Sports, indoor games etc. are also available.
