## **GENERAL RULES OF DISCIPLINE (ADIKAVI NANNAYA UNIVERSITY)**

1. The syndicate shall have the power to supervise and control the residence and discipline of the students of University, and subject to provisions, in the code to regulate the conduct of any student in a college or hostel connected with college, and to take cognizance of any misconduct in any examinations or for a degree, diploma, license, title or mark of honour brought to the notice of the Syndicate by the responsible authorities of the College or one of the University authorities or the Registrar of the University or by a Chairman of a Board of examiners or a Chief Superintendent at any examination, and to punish such misconduct at any time by exclusion from any University Examination or from any convocation for the purpose of conferring degree either permanently or for a special period or by Cancelling University examination or by deprivation of any University Scholarship or Endowment held by such person by awarding such penalty as it deems proper.
2. The syndicate in exercise of the powers conferred upon it under the Act and the Code has therefore been pleased to make the following standing orders of the Syndicate in regard to the Students of the University and affiliated colleges.
  - a) The Principal of a college shall have complete power for the maintenance of discipline of the students of the college.
  - b) Principals may frame and issue from time to time disciplinary rules of a permanent or temporary character regulating the conduct within and outside the college or hostel premises of graduate and under graduate students on the rolls.
  - c) On the report of the Principal or other authorities all such breaches of discipline, as in the opinion of these authorities call for the imposition of rustication from Examination etc. as Punishment will be considered by the Syndicate will pass there on such orders as it deems necessary.

This does not prevent the syndicate from taking cognizance of serious breaches of discipline. When brought to its notice by any of the persons mentioned in Section (I) or Suo moto' and awarding rustication etc., as punishment.
  - d) Principals shall have power to inflict the following punishment in the interest of the Students of the institutions concerned: fine, loss of attendance, loss of term certificates, suspension, expulsion.
  - e) Ragging is prevented. If any student is found guilty of it, he/she will be immediately expelled from the college.
- 3 (a) The attendance, certificate shall be granted in accordance with Section 8 (8) of Chapter LX of Vol, of the code.



- (b) The annual attendance certificate once issued by the Principal of colleges shall not be cancelled by them, but the syndicate may direct the heads of College not to admit to any examination or to further courses of studies for a certain period students who are found guilty of serious offence of misconduct after the issue of attendance certificate.
- (c) The syndicate will not grant permission to combine attendance in the case of expelled students who may be admitted by the Principal during the academic year in which such expulsions are made.
- 4. The Principal shall place herself in communication where necessary with parents or guardians of the students who are very backward and do not show improvement or whose attendance is very irregular or conduct unsatisfactory. The name of students found incorrigible even after the warnings may be removed from the rolls after intimation to parents or guardians, the order of the Principal in the matter shall be final.
- 5. In case of serious indiscipline by students the Principal will, when possible, before taking disciplinary action, inform the parents or guardians of the nature of the acts of indiscipline committed by such students and request the parents or guardians to exercise in favour of discipline.
- 6. If any student is expelled from college, intimation of the fact of expulsion with a statement of the reason therefore shall be given forth by the Principal (a) to the parent or guardian of the student and (b) shall be accompanied by the transfer certificate of the student or his parent or guardian may after making such enquiry as deem proper deliver the certificate to the student with necessary endorsements or withhold it temporarily or permanently.
- 7. The Principal of college may prohibit students from attending political or other meetings if she apprehends a breach of peace. The enrolment of students as volunteers for special work in connection with political meetings does not constitute of their part taking an active part in the proceedings. The volunteers on no account be used for political purpose.
- 8 (a) Students of college going on strike or in any way guilty of serious indiscipline shall ipsofacto immediately forfeit their scholarships, fee concession etc.,  
(b) Scholarships, fee concession etc, thus forfeited shall not ordinarily be restored.
- 9. Students of colleges going on strike, in any way guilty of serious breaches of discipline shall be required if they are residents of the attached hostels to quit the hostels at 15 hours notice and they shall not ordinarily be readmitted to the privileges of residence in the Hostel.
- 10. Memorials, Petitions or complaints from individual students of any college to any higher authority must be submitted through the Head of College.

## **ADMISSION RULES UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMMES**

1. Candidate for admission into the first year of the three year degree courses B.Sc., or B.Com., must have passed the two year Examination conducted by the Board of Intermediate Examination, A.P. or any other examination accepted by the syndicate as equivalent there to Students studying in another College of Andhra Pradesh seeking admission in the College in the middle of an academic year, shall have to obtain the prior sanction of the Syndicate for combination of the attendance in the two institutions, for which application will have to be made through the Principal of the College which the student leaves.
2. Those who do not live with their parents or certified guardians should be prepared to reside in the college hostel.

### **ADMISSION PROCESS THROUGH OAMDC (ONLINE ADMISSION MODULE FOR DEGREE COLLEGES)**

- ◆ On successful payment of processing fee, Application Number and Password will be provided through SMS to the Mobile number furnished at the time of filling the Registration page.
- ◆ By clicking the “Click here for Submitting the Application Details” the Online Application shall be filled. Photograph and signature of the candidate need to be uploaded.
- ◆ Candidates whose certificate data is already verified through web services can proceed for exercising web-options as per schedule.
- ◆ For candidates whose certificate data is incomplete, an SMS will be sent to upload the certificates for verification. The candidate can also attend verification of certificates at HLC after uploading them.
- ◆ By entering the Application Number, date of birth and password the candidate can exercise the options from Home, subject to availability of internet facility/Internet Café/Helpline Center.
- ◆ In respect of candidates whose data is not verified, SMS will be sent to the registered Mobile Number to re-upload the certificates. The candidate can also visit the nearest HLC for verification of certificates.

- ◆ Such Candidates are informed that the verification of certificates viz SSC memo, Intermediate marks memo, VI class to Intermediate study certificates, Caste Certificate, Income Certificate/Ration Card, Economically Weaker section(EWS) certificate, Physically Challenged Certificate, Residence Certificate will be verified by verification officers.
- ◆ CANDIDATES BELONGING TO SPECIAL CATEGORY LIKE CAP, NCC/ EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES/SPORTS AND PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED SHALL REPORT TO THE SPECIFIED HELP LINE CENTRE FOR VERIFICATION ON THE SPECIFIED DATES INDICATED IN THE SCHEDULE.
- ◆ Unless the candidate fills in the application details online and exercises web options, he will not be considered for allotment of a seat.
- ◆ Candidates are informed that there are 14 Helpline Centers across the state of A.P and the list is provided in Annexure-I.
- ◆ ALL THE CANDIDATES NEED NOT go to help line centers for verification of certificates. In case of candidates whose data is verified, displayed and agreed, they can directly proceed for option entry as per the schedule.
- ◆ For such of the candidates whose data is incomplete, their data will not be displayed. Such Candidates alone have to report to Help Line Centre and get the data verified and proceed for option entry.
- ◆ For any help such as change of Mobile number, Non Receipt of Login Id, Registration Number or any other corrections, candidates are requested to approach nearest Help Line centers with valid proof.
- ◆ Allotments now made are subject to the grant of affiliation from the University.

- ◆ The local candidate status under AU and SVU areas will be determined as per the territorial jurisdiction of the Universities before re-organization of districts in A.P

- 10) Local status certificate (if applicable) i.e a candidate who migrates to any part of the state of Andhra Pradesh from the state of Telangana from 02- June-2014 to on/before 01-June- 2022 shall be regarded as the local candidate in the state of Andhra Pradesh.
- 11) Candidates claiming reservation under NCC/Sports/ PH/ CAP shall bring the original certificates.
  - a) PH - Candidates shall submit certificate issued by the District Medical Board.
  - b) CAP - Candidates shall submit certificates from the Zilla Sainik Welfare Board (viz) Discharge book & Identity card etc for Verification. Children of Ex-Service and In- Service persons who are domicile of Andhra Pradesh will alone be considered for allotment of seats under CAP Category.
  - c) NCC & Sports – Produce original certificates issued by competent authorities. The candidate should have represented from the state of AP.
  - d) Minorities - Muslim and Christian Minority Candidates should produce TC of the SSC containing the Religion (Muslim/Christian/Other linguistic) or in the absence of TC, a Certificate issued by the Head of the Institution in which the student studied/appeared for SSC or its equivalent Examination.
  - e) Extracurricular activities: Candidates claiming reservation under this category shall produce relevant certificates

### **M.SC-CHEMISTRY (ORGANIC)**

1/ II class B.Sc. with Maths, Physics and Chemistry as one of the Optionals.

The Candidate shall be admitted into the above programmes on the basis of rank obtained by the candidate in an entrance examination conducted by the University after having satisfied the above mentioned eligibility criteria and in accordance with the rules and regulations including reservations, formulated by the University from time to time.

#### **WITHDRAWAL AND ISSUE OF CERTIFICATES**

1. If a student leaves the college during the year, she cannot claim remission of any portion of the fees due for the term.
2. A Student who has duly paid her fees, if she leaves college, will be granted transfer certificate provided, she applied for it with the counter signature of the parent/guardian. The T. C. will be given on the next working day only.
3. Any request for original marks list for one or two days by the Candidate should be made in writing and signed by the Principal.

#### **ATTENDANCE**

1. Each student is required to attend punctually at the stated hours to lectures and practical classes.
2. The students are required to put in 100% attendance. However 75% of minimum attendance is strictly required to make them eligible to appear for the examination.
3. For cogent reasons like sickness a student be allowed upto 25% absence on submission of a bonafide certificate. This may be scrupulously followed and implemented.
  - (a) The absence of a student without leave for any single hour in a session results in the loss of attendance for the whole session.
  - (b) A student who has to absent herself shall apply for leave to the Principal through her ward tutor and the ward tutor who shall, after ascertaining the facts, forward the applications with her remarks to the Principal. Applications for leave of absence which can be foreseen sufficiently in advance should be submitted on the Previous working day to the Tutor and her permission taken before leave is availed Application for leave of absence which cannot be foreseen in advance should be submitted immediately when the occasion arises.

### **CONDUCT**

1. Every student shall wear a clean and decent dress approved by the principal
2. Students are required to observe order at all times in the college and make little noise as possible in moving from one room to another. They are prohibited from loitering in verandahs, during class hours even though they may be free at the moment.
3. Students are required to help in keeping the class rooms and premises tidy
4. Students are expected to greet their teachers when they meet them. They should make room for members of the staff in passages, verandahs and buses.
5. Students are prohibited from organising any meetings entertainments at the college for collecting money for any purpose within the college without the permission of the principal.
6. Students guilty of going over to other colleges to take part in acts of indiscipline such as organising demonstrations and strikes would be deemed especially culpable and would be punished accordingly.
7. Students shall not hold any meetings for criticising the conduct of the University or authorities of the College. Such meetings shall be deemed to be unlawful and the principal might take such action as she deems necessary to prohibit or to punish and in case she considers it very serious to report to the syndicate under section two or chapter VII of the code for rustication etc.
8. Regarding all matters not specified in the foregoing rules, students shall aim at conducting themselves according to the higher standard of manner with which these are acquainted with due regard to the rights of the others.

### **CLASS-ROOM**

1. On the teachers entering the class room the students should rise and remain standing till they are asked to sit or till the teacher takes her seat.
2. No pupil shall be allowed to leave the class room without the permission of her teacher or until the class is dismissed. A student, so permitted shall take permission slip from the teacher.
3. Students are expected to assemble in the class room within five minutes after the appointed hour. Then the roll shall be called and the attendance of the student will be noted. A student coming into the class room after roll call may be refused admission, or deprived of attendance for the period or recommended to the principal for punishment.
4. A student who disturbs a lesson or makes mischief in a class may be expelled from the class by the lecturer. A pupil so expelled shall be deemed to be sent for that half-day without leave. All such cases shall be reported to the Principal.

**COLLEGE EXAMINATION AND  
PROGRESS CERTIFICATE**

1. No student will be allowed to absent herself from slip tests and examinations except under special circumstances. Application for leave must be supported by the recommendation of ward tutor and medical certificate. If not, will be taken as absence without leave.
2. Progress Report shall be sent regularly and the parents have to go through the Report-Marks, attendance etc., and sign in the prescribed column.
3. The attendance and progress certificate which should be sent to the Board/ University at the end of the course for enabling a student to sit for the Board/University Examination, will be issued by the Principal.

### **EXAMINATION RULES FOR P.G.**

There shall be an examination conducted by the Andhra University at the Semester end for all the courses prescribed for study in this year.

1. Marks for sessional work shall be allotted by the teaching staff of the concerned college on the basis of classwork, slip tests, practical work etc., and the list of marks shall be sent to the Registrar, Andhra University, before the commencement of written examination.
2. For taking the examination in the theory or practical in any subject the candidate shall be required to obtain of 50% in sessional work in that subject failing which the candidate shall be required to repeat the course in that subject in the semester in which it is offered again for study.
3. Candidates who failed to get minimum marks as prescribed here-in-after in any subject will be premitted to continue the studies in the next year. They shall however be required to pass the examination in the subjects in which they have failed in the subsequent examinations. There shall be no provision for improvement of sessionals.
4. Candidate who have secured not less than 40% in each subject in the semester end examination not less than 50% of the total marks for sessionals and semester-end examination marks put together shall be declared to have passed in that subject.
5. Candidates who have passed all the subjects of the course and secured not less than 60% in aggregate of marks in their first appearance shall be declared to have passed in First Calss. All remaining successful shall be declared to have passed in the Second Class.
