



2. Number Coding -

3. Mixed Coding -

In this type of question, three or four complete messages are given in the coded language and the code for a particular word is asked.

To analyse such codes, any two messages bearing the common word are picked up. The common code word will mean that word. Proceeding similarly by picking up all possible combinations of two messages the entire message can be analysed.

To ensure personalized attention and maximize the effectiveness of the learning outcomes, the students were divided into four separate batches.

Topics Covered in the Training Program:

- 1. **Quantitative Aptitude:** The program commenced with an extensive exploration of quantitative aptitude, a pivotal component of software company written tests. Students received comprehensive guidance on mathematical concepts and problem-solving techniques relevant to these assessments. Ms. P. Sowjanya and Mr. Sk. Sadik provided thorough training in aptitude topics.
